All TTT-2 certified technicians interested in taking the Foreman Certification Exam are eligible to be sponsored on their first attempt. Foreman exams sponsored by AT&T will be available on a first come, first served basis and limited to a single exam application.

All TTT-2 certified technicians who are taking the Foreman Certification exam for the first time are eligible to receive one-time sponsorship funding.
